ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

YUCCA VALLEY TROJAN CROSS COUNTRY AND TRACK BOOSTER CLUB INC.

I. The name of the corporation is YUCCA VALLEY TROJAN CROSS COUNTRY AND TRACK BOOSTER CULB INC. II.

This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for public purposes. This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

III.

The specific purpose of this corporation is to engage in fundraising activities for the sports of cross country running and track and field at Yucca Valley High School, and for any other youth sports programs or activities deemed appropriate by the board of directors. Fundraising activities will include solicitation of donations from community businesses, service organizations, and individuals, and profit-making activities, including car washes, candy sales, benefit dinners, and the sale of "Walk of Fame" bricks. In addition to raising funds, the corporation will promote the development of athletic skills for cross country, track and field athletes, as well as the development of team members as responsible contributing citizens in our community through emphasis on academic excellence, college preparation, participation in school and community activities, community service, and responsible citizenship.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statement) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

VII.

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to its charitable and educational purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private person.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under IRC Section 501(c)(3).
